SCC DFCS is engaged in a Strategic Planning process to set our course for the future. Today is your first opportunity to give input on core elements of the plan as it's being developed.

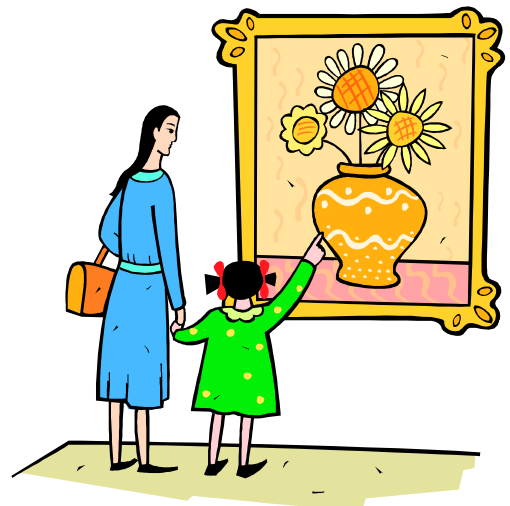
- You'll hear more about the Strategic Plan over the next few months and can give us more input along the way.
